Three times bronze award for Weltons Ltd

In the SIBA regional competition for the south east on 3rd July 2009 we successfully won three bronze awards for three of our fantastic beers. After entering a beer in each category we were very happy to hear the outcome!

For those not so familiar with SIBA it is the Society of Independent Brewers formed in 1980 and was then known as the Small Independent Brewers' Association. The association was formed in order to 'represent the interests of the emerging new wave of microbrewers' (SIBA.co.uk). It was in 1995 that the association was renamed as the Society of Independent Brewers and has earned its position as an influential and respected society within the industry.

On 3rd July Weltons Ltd was awarded with three bronze awards in the following categories: Milds (Up to 4.0%); Strong Bitters (5.1% - 5.5%); Porters, Strong Milds, Old Ales & Stouts. The fantastic beers that succeeded were as follows.

Milds (Up to 4.0%)	Sussex Pride	4% abv
Strong Bitters (5.1% - 5.5%)	Old Harry	5.2% abv
Porters, Strong Milds, Old Ales & Stouts	Export Stout	4.7% abv
